

## Ronald B. Kuppersmith, MD

Ron Kuppersmith, MD, FACS, is a board certified Otolaryngologist and has practiced in Bryan-College Station since 2003. He also works in our Huntsville office. He is a clinical faculty member of the Texas A&M Health Science Center. From 1999 to 2003, he practiced in Seattle, Washington at the Virginia Mason Medical Center, a tertiary care center for otolaryngology-head and neck surgery and served on the clinical faculty of the University of Washington Medical School.

Dr. Kuppersmith is among the first surgeons in North America to successfully perform robot-assisted endoscopic thyroid surgery using the daVinci Surgical System.

Dr. Kuppersmith currently serves as the President of the American Academy of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery, as Past President of the Texas Association of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery, and on the Board of Trustees of the College Station Medical Center. He is a Senior Examiner for the American Board of Otolaryngology. He has received numerous awards including being selected by his peers for inclusion in the "Best Doctors in America", the "Guide to America's Top Physicians" by the Consumers' Research Council of America, a Distinguished Service Award and an Honor Award from the American Academy of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery. He serves on the Editorial Boards of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery, Laryngoscope, and ENT Journal. He has given over 100 invited lectures in the United States, Asia, Europe, and South America.

Dr. Kuppersmith is a Fellow of the American Academy of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery, a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons, a Fellow of the American Academy of Otolaryngic Allergy, and is a member of the American Thyroid Association, Texas Medical Association, Texas Association of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery, and the Brazos-Robertson County Medical Society.

Dr. Kuppersmith attended the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor for his undergraduate degree and for medical school. He completed his residency in Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery at Baylor College of Medicine in Houston, Texas which included service at the Methodist Hospital, St. Luke's Hospital, MD Anderson Cancer Center, Texas Childrens Hospital, Ben Taub General Hospital and the Michael E. DeBakey Veterans Affairs Medical Center.
